WELCOME,

Come and gather with the Church of SP&SP for worship in our sanctuary at 10:30 AM on Sundays (with distanced seating, masks, and precautions in place).

Upon entering the church parking lot:

- Please keep a parking spot between each vehicle and maintain all appropriate distancing with one another.
- All worshippers will have their temperatures taken by a scanning device aimed at the forehead and will be required to wear a mask to enter the building. If you do not have a mask one will be provided for you at the door. Please ask the usher for help if you are not sure where to sit.
- Please do not attend the service if you are experiencing symptoms consistent with the COVID19 virus. The bathrooms will be available for use by anyone. Please be thorough in washing your hands and be mindful of those who will use the bathroom afterward. We also ask that people keep a distance of six feet between each other in the parking lot and the sanctuary. Please do not congregate in the narthex for an extended period.

- Missals (order and liturgy of the service) will be placed on the pews at each designated spot. There will be no presentation of the gifts for consecration, passing of offering plates, or use of the hymnals. Monetary gifts for the worship of the Lord and support of our ministries may be given in the designated offering plate in the narthex or mailed into the church. (On Noisy Offering Sunday – additional monies collected for our missionaries- there will be an additional labeled offering plate in the narthex as well)
- When it comes time to receive communion, the usher and greeter will dismiss people row by row by person or family. Please wait at the designated “line” on the floor before the altar until Father Tom calls you up to receive the elements (this allows the altar to be cleaned between communicants).
- When you proceed to the altar, Father Tom will have the body and blood of the Lord placed on the altar for your reception and will briefly visit, bless, and pray with you in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. After receiving, please leave the sanctuary by the side aisle reverently and quietly.
