All,

We will begin to gather together again for worship in our sanctuary at 10:30 AM beginning on Sunday, September 6th, 2020 (with distancing, masks, and weekly sign-ups for spots in the sanctuary). Every Sunday, after the service, we will have a weekly sign-up sheet available in the narthex for the following Sunday's service. Visitors are also welcomed to sign-up. Every person may also sign up for each week's service by calling the church at 540-562-0511 or by e-mailing our office administrator (Val) at peterpaul@roacoxmail.com before Friday at noon each week.

Upon entering the church parking lot:

- Please keep a parking spot between each vehicle and maintain all appropriate distancing with one another.
- All worshippers will have their temperatures taken by a scanning device aimed at the forehead and will be required to wear a mask to enter the building. If you do not have a mask one will be provided for you at the door. Please ask the usher for help if you are not sure where to sit.
- Please do not attend the service if you are experiencing symptoms consistent with the COVID19 virus. The bathrooms will be available for use by anyone.

Please be thorough in washing your hands and be mindful of those who will use the bathroom afterward. We also ask that people keep a distance of six feet between each other in the parking lot and the sanctuary. Please do not congregate in the narthex for an extended period.

- Missals (order and liturgy of the service) will be placed on the pews at a person or family's designated spot. There will be no presentation of the gifts, passing of offering plates, or use of the hymnals. Monetary gifts may be given in the designated offering plate in the narthex or mailed into the church.
- When it comes time to receive communion, the usher and greeter will dismiss people from the front of the sanctuary to the back by person or family. Please wait at the designated "line" on the floor before the altar until Father Tom calls you up to receive the elements (this allows the altar to be cleaned between communicants).
- When you proceed to the altar, Father Tom will have the body and blood of the Lord placed on the altar for your reception and will briefly visit, bless, and pray with you in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ. After receiving, please leave the sanctuary by the middle isle reverently and quietly.

May the Lord bless and protect us all as we seek to responsibly and safely worship him together during this unique time.
